2017-2018 Tuition Rates

- Preschool MWF \$85 and TTH \$70 (this amount stays the same)
- Kindergarten \$1,300
- First Grade \$ 1,400
- Second sixth grade \$1,500
- Family Cap for Parishioners only \$3,500, Non-Parishioners No family cap.
